HIGHER LEVEL SKILLS PROGRAM

The Higher Level Skills program delivers a government subsidy to support eligible individuals to complete their first Certificate IV qualification. The Queensland Department of Education and Training provides this subsidy to help make training more affordable and accessible for you. The Higher Level Skills program is aimed towards students who require higher level skills that will help to secure employment or career advancement in a priority industry or further study.

Under this Funding program GET Education delivers training in:

CPC40110 Certificate IV in Building & Construction.

To be eligible for Higher Level Skills funding a student must:

- Be a Queensland resident
- Be aged 15 years and older
- Have finished secondary school or left school
- Be an Australian Citizen or permanent resident living in Queensland, (including humanitarian entrants) or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or a New Zealand citizen permanently residing in Queensland.
- Not already hold a Certificate IV qualification or higher
- Have a trade qualification (Certificate III) in the building and construction industry.

Prospective participants should note that, once they complete the course, they will no longer be able to access Queensland government subsidised training under the Higher Level Skills program.

Do I need to contribute to the cost of Higher Level Skills Training?

Given the increased benefits that you can gain from higher level training, you are expected to contribute to the cost of your training through a student co-contribution fee, payable to the training provider. The fee may be paid on your behalf by an employer or a third party but cannot be paid or waived by the GET Education Australia
